Board of Education Proceedings

The Canton School District Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, April 13, 2020 at 7:00 pm in the school library.

The meeting was live-streamed, with Jennifer Skiles, Josh Otkin, Principal Devitt, Principal Townsend, and Asst. Prin. Knudson attending by video conferencing. Members and others present: Christal Dietzenbach, Todd Gannon, Jon Gustad, Tanya Iverson, Scott Larson, Supt. Gerber and Business Manager Thompson.

The meeting was called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

No conflicts of interest were identified. All motions acted upon at this meeting were done by a roll call vote.

GBB; Andrew Steffensen-8<sup>th</sup> GBB; and Jake Versteeg-7<sup>th</sup> GBB; offer and accept contracts with Sarah Chapmen-MS Special Ed, and Shelly Eich-6<sup>th</sup> Language Arts; authorize membership in the SDHSAA for the 2020-21 school year; approve participation in ASBSD's Worker Compensation Pool for 2020-21; approve participation in ASBSD's Health Insurance Pool with a 0% increase; offer a contract to Jodi Baldwin-school nurse, for 2020-21 to be amended at a later date; transfer expense from Special Education to the General Fund for time spent with general ed students by the Behavioral Teacher and aide; and advertise for Food Service Proposals for Managed Services, with a due date of May 4, 2020.
