Board of Education Proceedings

The Canton School District Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, December 14, 2020 at 7:00 pm in the school library.

Members and others present: Christal Dietzenbach, Todd Gannon, Tanya Iverson, Robin Kappenman, Josh Otkin, by conference call Scott Larson, Supt. Terry Gerber, Principals' Gabe Devitt and Russ Townsend, Asst. Principal Knudson, Jeremy Ask and Business Manager Thompson.

A roll call vote was conducted for all items requiring board action.

The meeting was called to order by vice-chair J. Otkin and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

C. Dietzenbach moved, second by T. Gannon to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held Nov. 9, 2020.  
Aye: all members

No conflicts of interest were identified.

C. Dietzenbach moved, second by T. Iverson to approve the agenda. Aye: all members

T. Gannon moved, second by T. Iverson to approve the following consent agenda items: accept the resignations from Lacey Vekovius-SpEd teacher, Taylor Fechner-SpEd aide, Randal Nelson-Custodian and Deb Stahlecker-aide; offer and accept the full time custodian contract with Bob Miller at \$14.75 an hour, and the part time custodian contract with Dan Painter at \$14.30 an hour; approve the open enrollment request for 4 virtual learning students; increase the minimum wage from \$9.30 to \$9.45 an hour, effective Jan. 1, 2021; set the school board election for April 13, 2021 in conjunction with the city, if needed; and change the district property and liability insurance from Continental Western to EMC effective Dec. 1, 2020. Aye: all members

T. Gannon moved, second by C. Dietzenbach to approve the bills for payment. Aye: all members.

C. Dietzenbach moved, second by R. Kappenman to accept the financial statement for the month of November 2020. Aye: All members.

Administrative reports were given and included: elem. Activities, NWEA and NCRC achievement data for students, and winter virtual concerts.

Jeremy Ask, wrestling coach, and some of the girls participating in wrestling this year were present to discuss adding a girls' wrestling program.

12/21/2020 T. Gannon moved, second by C. Dietzenbach to offer girls wrestling at Canton School District and to create a budget for the program for the 20-21 school year. A girls wrestling coach salary is yet to be determined. Aye: all members

Discussion was held regarding the district's Return to Learn Plan and quarantine procedures.

12/22/2020 C. Dietzenbach moved, second by R. Kappenman to amend quarantine procedures for the Return To Learn Plan, for staff and students. Aye: all members

12/23/2020 T. Gannon moved, reluctantly, second by C. Dietzenbach to accept the early retirement request from Supt. Terry Gerber, effective at the end of the current school year. Supt. Gerber has been with Canton School District for 23 years. Aye: all members

12/24/2020 T. Gannon moved, second by S. Larson to approve the Intent to Return forms for 4 students who have applied to return to Canton School District, effective Jan. 4, 2021.
