The Canton School District Board of Education met in regular session on Tuesday, June 8, 2021 at 7:00 pm in the school library.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Larson and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

J. Otkin moved, second by T. Gannon to approve the minutes of the regular meeting held May 10, 2021.
