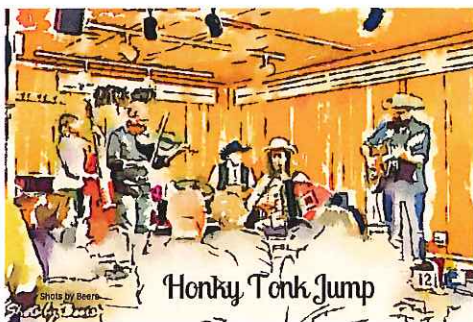
Sunday, February 17 • 2 p.m. **History of Town Halls in Canton**
