The Canton School District Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, May 9, 2016 at 7:00 pm, in the school library.

The meeting was called to order, and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Gustad to approve the agenda as amended, and the following consent agenda items: approve the minutes from the regular meeting held April 11 and the special meeting held April 28, 2016; accept the resignation from Denyce Campbell-elem. aide: offer and accept contracts with Kara Werning-elem. music teacher and Kaitlyn Pederson-MS Counselor; accept the certified teaching and extra duty contracts for 2016-17 to be amended upon completion of the negotiation's process; offer secretary contracts for 2016-17 to be amended upon completion of the negotiation's process; Congratulate Joie Jockheck selected teacher of the year for Canton School District; recognize and congratulate the 55 members of the Class of 2016; approve the use of food service funds to cover the cost of the elementary milk break for 2015-16; approve the SD Dept. of Education waiver that allows Canton School District to offer high school graduation credit for 8th graders who take and pass Algebra I (five year approval); Appoint the Bond Election Board of-Marcene Nelson-chair, Linda Ripley and Faye Fossum for the Bond election to be held June 7, 2016; renew the Workmen's compensation insurance agreement with ASBSD for 2016-17; renew the agreement with CBM food service management for the 2016-17 school year, with the rate to be determined by the Federal Register notice in July; approve the purchase of the property located at 820 N. Cedar Street in Canton; approve the five year contract with American Bus Corporation of Canton with a 3% annual increase; and vote for the SDHSAA amendment and cast a ballot for Jim Aisenbrey for the open position.
