Board of Education Proceedings

The Canton School District Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, March 14, 2016 at 7:00 pm, in the school library.

The meeting was called to order, and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

T. Larson moved, second by C. Dietzenbach to approve the agenda as amended, and the following consent agenda items: approve the minutes from the regular meeting held February 8 and the special governance meeting held Feb. 11, 2016; accept the resignation effective at the end of the 2015-16 school year from Cheri Englert (37 years); accept admin. contracts for 2016-17 to be amended at a later date from-Supt.
