The Canton School District Board of Education met in regular session on Monday, April 9, 2018 at 7:00 pm in the school library.

The meeting was called to order and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A conflict of interest was identified for J.Gustad with the elem. secretary contract.

T. Gannon moved, second by T. Larson to approve the agenda as amended adding Title I remedial reading new certified position when eliminating the certified full time elem. library position, adding a teacher resignation, and adding approval of the workmen's compensation plan for 2018-19; to approve the following consent agenda items: approve the minutes of the regular meeting held March 12, 2018; appoint Kathy Hill as a replacement election board worker; approve the proposed calendar for 2018-19; accept contracts from Terry Gerber-Supt. and Kent Knudson-Asst. Principal/Act. Director, to be amended upon completion of the negotiations process; accept the resignations effective at the end of the current school year from Jenna Stearns and Jeremiah Peterson; accept the open enrollment application for one student from Sioux Falls as allowed by SDCL 13-28-43(3); amend the 2017-18 calendar adding May 17 and 18 as two instructional days due to snow days; authorize membership in the SDHSAA for 2018-19; and offer 2018-19 contracts to all returning certified staff for 2018-19 – to be amended upon completion of the negotiations process. J. Gustad moved, second by J. Skiles to accept the financial statement for the month of March, 2018. Aye: all members

Administrative reports were given and included the following: conferences were well attended, testing is underway, staff has been arranged for the Ready To Start Program this summer at the elementary, Kindergarten Roundup will be held April 17 and 19, and band students are back from a very successful trip to Florida.

Athletic Trainer Proposals were received from Sanford and Avera. Proposals were reviewed by a committee with the recommendation to enter into a five year agreement with Sanford. The scope of service provided by Avera the last several years has been excellent.

The Board discussed replacing the certified elem. librarian with an aide and adding a Title I reading teacher in order to get more teacher time with students for math and reading.

Iverson to offer and accept a contract with Sarah Gustad as elementary secretary, to begin August 1, 2018, contract to be amended upon completion of the secretaries' negotiations process. Aye: C. Dietzenbach, B. Henke, J. Skiles, T. Larson, T. Iverson, T. Gannon Abstain: J. Gustad Motion carried

<u>4/25/2018</u> J. Skiles moved, second by T. Gannon to offer and accept a contract with Nicole Sehr as Latchkey Director to begin April 1, 2018. Aye: all members

Canton School District has received health insurance rates from ASBSD Benefits Fund for 2018-19 with a 0% increase. The District has the option to add a \$5,000 deductible, however we are limited to offering four deductible options. Added to the elective options for the new plan year is an employee and dependents elective for each deductible plan.

<u>4/26/2018</u> T. Larson moved, second by J. Gustad to accept the health insurance rates from ASBSD for the 2018-19 school year and offer plan deductibles of \$1,000., \$2,000., \$2,500., and \$5,000. Aye: all members

<u>4/27/2018</u> T. Gannon moved, second by J.Skiles to adopt the workmen's compensation proposal from ASBSD for the period July 1, 2018 – June 30, 2019, which includes premium stabilization reserve applied for rate relief in the amount of \$9,141. Aye: all members

The Board reviewed the Capital Outlay Proposed Budget for 2018-19 which includes the five year plan and requisition requests.

T. Larson moved, second by J. Skiles, moving the board to executive session at 8:00 pm to prepare for negotiations pursuant to SDCL 1-25-2. Regular session resumed at 8:50 pm.
