Larson to approve the agenda, and the following consent agenda items: approve the minutes of the regular meeting held March 10<sup>th</sup> and the special meeting held April 3, 2014; accept the resignations from Gwenn Archer-Spanish and Ryan Williams-Custodian; offer and accept the contracts with Kris Dunlap-7-12 Instrumental Music, Jenna Stearns-5-6 Instrumental Music, Jordan Hout-HS Science, and Jacob Versteeg-6-12 Vocal Music; approve the open enrollment request for one elementary student; authorize membership in the SDHSAA for the 2014-15 school year; accept 2014-15 contracts from Terry Gerber, Russ Townsend, Gabe Devitt, Sarah Richarz, Bob Falk, Darin Sehr, and Nancy Thompson; and approve the audit contract with Quam & Berglin for the year ending June 30, 2014. T. Zylstra moved, second by T. Larson to approve the bills for payment. Aye: all members

B. Henke moved, second by K. Jensen to accept the financial statement for the month of March, 2014. Aye: all members

Administrative reports were given, and included the following: Family Fun Night at the elementary school was a success, Kind. Assessment are completed, elem. school activities, Title I program changes for 2014-15, summer school planning, and a new summer program to be offered sponsored by United Way, "Ready To Learn". The MS/HS report reviewed activities, the possibility of offering Project Lead The Way classes to students from neighboring districts when space allows; and plans to facilitate a Gifted and Talented Program for 2014-15.

The Superintendent's report reviewed discussions with SDHSAA, specs for the armory roof to be developed by HD Designs, and the track resurfacing; creation of a Professional development leadership team to administer training provided by the state; and discussion regarding the custodial opening.

The Board committee received lunch management proposals on April 4<sup>th</sup>. Using the review criteria their recommendation was to contract with CBM for the 2014-15 school year.
