Board of Education Proceedings

The Canton School District Board of Education met in regular session on September 9, 2013 at 6:00 pm, in the school library.

Members and others present: Bruce Henke, Tanya Iverson, Kevin Jensen, Todd Larson, Emily Plucker, and Craig Stearns.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stearns.

T. Iverson moved, second by T. Larson to approve the agenda as amended, and the following consent agenda items: approve the minutes from August 12, 2013; approve the Workmen's Compensation Agreement with ASBSD; accept the resignation from Steve Sandnes-custodian; approve the contract with Kim Sogn-Community Ed/Latchkey director in the amount of \$30,285.; approve the lane change request from Ronda Gage from BA to BA30 in the amount of \$830.; approve the 9 open enrollment applications; approve renewal of the Flex-Plan Agreement with a September 1,2013 effective date; and approve the insurance renewal with Canton Insurance Agency for 2013-14. K. Jensen moved, second by E. Plucker to approve the bills for payment. Aye: all members

B. Henke moved, second by T. Larson to accept the financial statement for the month of August, 2013. Aye: all members

Administrative reports were given and included the following: enrollment, events at Lawrence Elementary, and start of the year activities at the Middle School and High School.

The Superintendent's report reviewed the Black Hills Online Learning Community, and the Summer Legislative Study.

After reviewing changes made to the 2013-14 Proposed Budget, the following resolution was made:

<u>9/7/13</u> B. Henke moved, second by E. Plucker to adopt the following: Let it be resolved that the School Board of the Canton School District, after duly considering the proposed budget, and its changes thereto, hereby approves and adopts its proposed budget as amended, to be its annual budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014. The adopted Annual budget levy requests are as follows: General Fund-Ag \$2.09, Owner Occupied \$4.296, Other and Utilities \$9.20; Capital Outlay Fund \$2.59, Special Education Fund \$1.552, and Pension Fund \$.30; the dollar amount for the Bond Redemption Fund is \$493,963. Total appropriations: General Fund \$4,936,997; Capital Outlay fund \$1,008,690; Special Education Fund \$1,049,956; Food Service Fund \$334,750; Bond Redemption Fund \$494,463; and Pension Fund \$158,823. After discussion regarding long term substitutes, the following motion was made:

<u>9/8/13</u> T. Larson moved, second by K. Jensen to contract a long term teacher substitute at a daily rate of \$120. This will be used for those substitutes hired with the intent of working 20 or more consecutive days in the same classroom. Aye: all members

The board watched a presentation by CGI for online advertising with the County.

<u>9/9/13</u> T. Larson moved, second by B. Henke to renew the Daktronics scoreboard service agreement with a three year contract at \$5,215. per year. Aye: all members
