The meeting was called to order. K. Jensen moved, second by T. Iverson, aye-all members, moving the board to executive session for the hearing at 6:00 pm. The Board was declared out of executive session at 7:20 pm.

11/12/14 E. Plucker moved, second by T. Iverson to uphold the 90 school days suspension for the student. Aye: all members

The regular meeting was called to order by Chairman Stearns and opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. The following were present: Bruce Henke, Tanya Iverson, Kevin Jensen, Todd Larson, Emily Plucker and Craig Stearns, Supt. Gerber, Principals Townsend and Devitt, Special Ed Director Richarz, AD E. Smart, Building and Grounds D. Sehr, Leann Lohan, Kristen Dunlap, Brooke Fodness, and Business Manager Thompson.

T. Larson moved, second by K. Jensen to approve the agenda as amended, and the following consent agenda items: approve the minutes from the October 13, 2014 meeting; accept the resignations from Dylan Krejci and John Bon Jour custodians; offer and accept contracts with Jeremy Ask, 7-8 gr. Head wrestling coach \$2,016, and Josh Montgomery-HS assist. wrestling coach \$2,850; and offer a contract to Brandon Jarmon as assist. MS wrestling coach. Aye: all members

B. Henke moved, second by E. Plucker to approve the bills for payment. Aye: all members

K.Jensen moved, second by T.Larson to accept the financial statement for the month of October, 2014. Aye: all members

Administrative reports were given and included: elem. reading curriculum to be reviewed, new playground equipment update, and elem. positive behavior re-enforcement; HS St. council activities, ACT Prep Program; Special Ed program updates; winter sports to begin soon, and upcoming concerts.

The Superintendent's report reviewed information regarding the teacher shortage.

The board reviewed possible plans for the armory roof and the cost involved.

<u>11/13/14</u> T. Larson moved, second by K. Jensen to reject the steel roof bid, rescinding motion 7/1/14, which was contingent upon the structural engineer signing of on the projected drainage report, and to rebid for a rubber roof. Aye: all members

11/14/14 B. Henke moved, second by T. Iverson to amend the 2014-15 General Fund Budget as follows, to reflect the increased enrollment due to the Black Hills On-Line Learning students: Increase state aid revenue by \$186,306 for total state aid of \$2,454,554; increase current tax to reflect confirmed valuations, by \$18,327. for a total tax of \$1,856,600; increase the General fund expense budget by \$126,750., from \$5,091,314.31 to \$5,218,064.31 to account for online tuition costs in Elementary (\$74,750), Middle School (\$26,000) and High School (\$26,000). The net effect of the Budget amendment is an increase to revenue of \$77,883. Aye: all members
